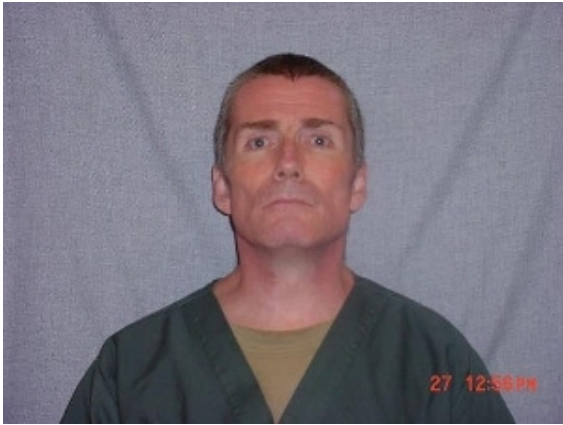
The Fond du Lac Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 and 301.46 (Act 440), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when, at the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agencies. Further, his previous criminal history places the offender in a classification level which reflects the potential to re-offend.

This sex offender has served the sentence imposed on him by the courts and has advised officials that he will be living at 457 Thomas Street in the City of Fond du Lac. THIS PERSON IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME. THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTENDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until passage of Act 440 (which mandates sex offender registration) that law enforcement even knew where they were living. In many cases, law enforcement is now able to share that information with you. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate, or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcement's ability to do community notification. We believe the only person who wins if community notification ends is the sex offender, since sex offenders derive their power through secrecy.

The Fond du Lac Police Department is available to help you set up Neighborhood Watches and to provide you with useful information on personal safety. Tracy S. Newhouse is being released back into the community, after serving 9 years with the Department of Corrections for 3 counts of Possession of Child Pornography and 2 counts of Felony Bail Jumping.

Newhouse's conviction resulted from him cutting out multiple pictures of young girls and gluing pictures of male sex organs on their mouths so they depicted children performing fellatio. He has been known to frequent video stores, book stores and libraries, altering books and video jackets by cutting out pictures.

Special conditions of Tracy Newhouse's supervised release:

- 1) No unsupervised contact with minors; no presence in taverns, bars, or liquor stores; and no use of alcohol or illegal drugs.
- 2) Comply with standard sex offender rules and cooperate with GPS and electronic monitoring.
- 3) Face-to-face contact with law enforcement as required.
- 4) Comply with all requirements of lifetime registration with Wisconsin Sex Offender Registration Program.

Tracy S. Newhouse will be living at 457 Thomas Street in the City of Fond du Lac when he is released on September 5, 2010. Newhouse will be required to wear a GPS monitoring bracelet.
